

Restaurants in the Lancaster-Littleton area

Lancaster isn't that large a town, but actually has a pretty good diversity of places to eat. Almost all are located on Main Street (Route 2/3). From North to south:

TJ's Truck Stop (100 Bridge St., just this side of the Connecticut River on Route 2)

Happy Star (96 Bridge St.): Chinese

Sylvia's Lunch Break (257 Summer St., east of Route 3 north of town): breakfast and lunch only

McDonald's (258 Main St.)

Smokin' T's BBQ (212 Main St.): Never been here, but they're catering the picnic.

Subway (202 Main St.)

Dunkin' Donuts (196 Main St.)

Scorpio's Pizzeria and Sport's Pub (180 Main St.): has outdoor seating, good variety of beers

Lancaster House of Pizza (95 Main St.)

Polish Princess (73 Main St.): bakery, breakfast and lunch options

Granite Grind (70 Main St.): never been here, breakfast and lunch only

J.L. Sullivan's Irish Pub (26 Main St.): also a good beer selection

A few miles south on Route 3 in Whitefield is:

Grandma's Kitchen (187 Lancaster Road)

Whitefield also has a Subway, Dunkin' Donuts, pizza place, and convenience stores.

Farther Afield, there are a LOT of options in Littleton, including the expected chains like 99 and Applebees. Of note in Littleton is a very good brew-pub:

Schilling Beer Company (18 Mill St.): really good wood-fired pizza and pub fare, plus beer!

There are a couple of options in Bethlehem (east of Littleton on Route 302):

Rek-Lis Brewing Company (44 Pinewood Ave): Friday-Saturday only. I hear it's good.
