

VERMONT: North Sites

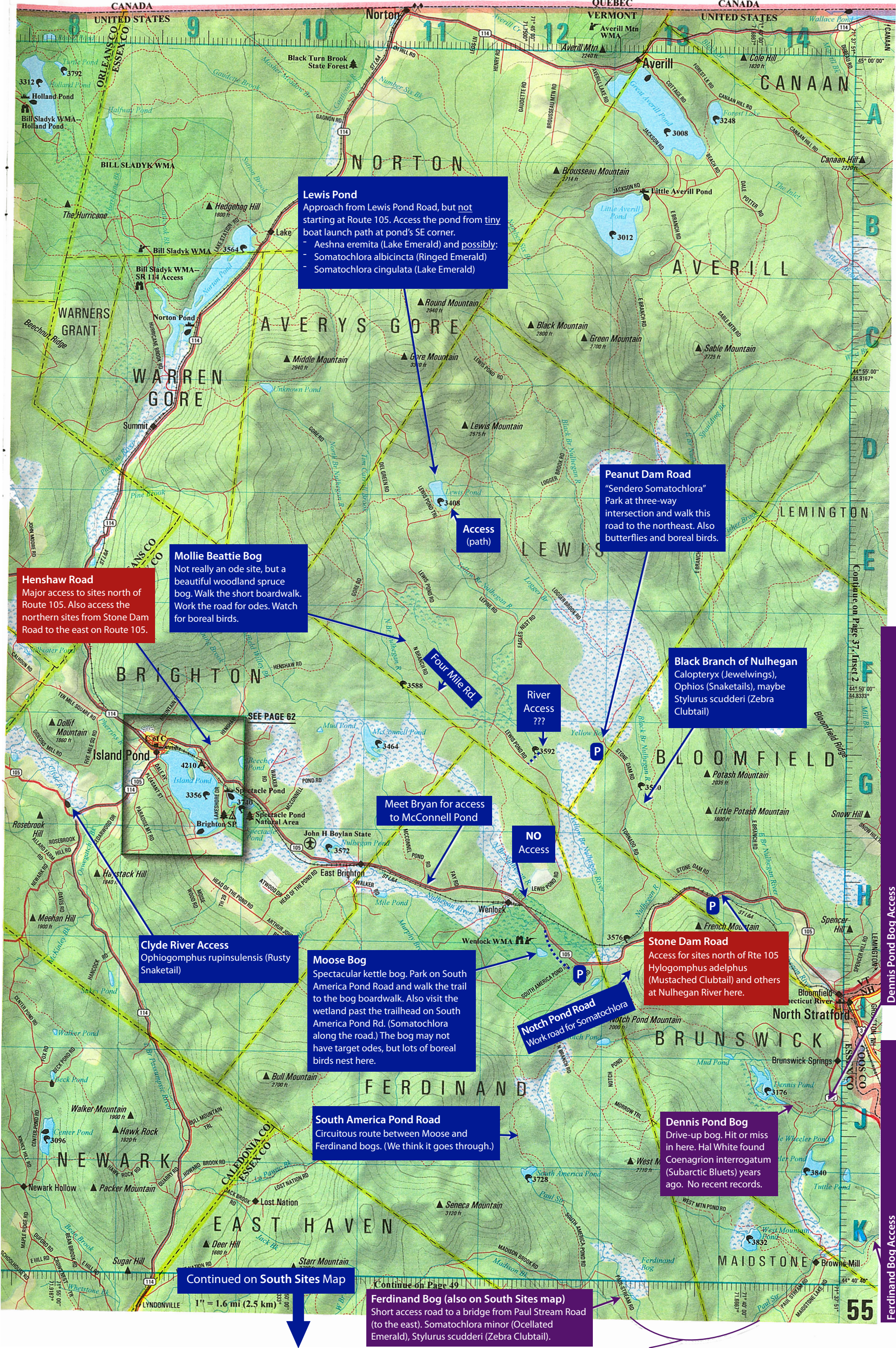
Your two access points to sites north of Route 105 are **Henshaw Road** about a mile east on Route 105 from downtown in the village of Island Pond, and **Stone Dam Road** (into the Conte-Nulhegan National Wildlife Refuge) about 12.6 miles east on Route 105 from downtown Island Pond. Reach **Dennis Pond Bog** and **Ferdinand Bog** (SE corner of this map) from roads off of Route 102.

Note: These gravel roads are generally passable to most vehicles, but recent storms may have changed that. Cell coverage is spotty here. GPS is best.



Dennis Pond Bog Access
From Route 102, use Dennis Pond Road, which is 1.8 miles from the Route 105 intersection, but keep left at the first fork, then right at next two to get on the road south of the pond.

Dennis Pond Bog Access
From Route 102, use Maidenstone Lake Road, which is 5.2 miles from the Route 105 intersection, but take Paul Stream Road to the bog.
