Ferdinand Bog Access

From Route 102, use Maidstone Lake Road, which is 5.2 miles from the Route 105 intersection, but take Paul Stream Road to the bog.

To Route 102

Maidstone Lake Rd. /

Ferdinand Bog
From Paul Stream Road find a short access road to a bridge. Somatochlora minor (Ocellated Emerald), Stylurus scudderii (Zebra Clubtail). On the way, stop at Paul Stream now and then.

Bog Brook Trail

Walk it for *Somatochlora minor* (Ocellated Emerald) and other species. Trail likely to be flooded. Gray Jays and Black-backed Woodpecker are regular here.

Pipeline Right of Way

Consider walking pipeline road 1.2 miles east along wetlands to a brook.

Rogers Road (see inset map below)
Just south of the pipeline. Park and walk past the gate to a brook crossing for Hagenius (Dragonhunter) *Stylurus scuderi* (Zebra Clubtail) and *Ophiogomphus* (Snaketails).

Moose River
Stop wherever along River Road and visit the river for *Ophiogomphus* (Snaketail) and other river species.
